Museum of the American Revolution:

Enjoy a journey through the remarkable story of America's founding and gain a deeper understanding of the people, events, and ideals that gave birth to a nation at the newly-opened Museum of the American Revolution in the historic area of Philly.

Eastern State Penitentiary:

Known for its grand architecture and strict discipline, this was the world's first true "penitentiary," a prison designed to inspire penitence, or true regret, in the hearts of prisoners. Built in 1829 and closed in 1971, it was once "home" to Al Capone and other famous prisoners.
