> FLIGHT TO OBLIVION The extinction of the passenger pigeon

Game Commission NE Region Information and Education Supervisor William Williams will present *Flight to Oblivion, The extinction of the passenger pigeon.*

"The passenger pigeon was once the most abundant bird in North America and expansive nesting colonies occurred throughout Pennsylvania each spring," said Williams. "Their numbers went from billions to none in only a few decades. The last

passenger pigeon in captivity, named Martha, died at the Cincinnati Zoo in September 1914, marking the end of a species."

Flight to Oblivion explores the reasons for the bird's demise and how its extinction prompted state and federal legislation that now provides protection to existing migratory bird species. This informative and entertaining program will be of interest to bird enthusiasts, historians, and anyone interested in wildlife conservation.
